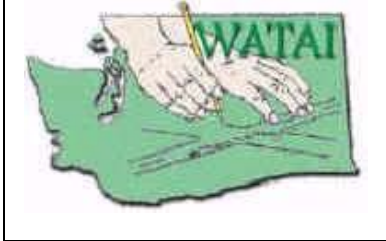

Course Description: This course is designed for experienced traffic crash investigators who have a good working knowledge of the techniques and applications of formulas taught in basic crash investigation courses that wish to build upon that foundation by developing the specialized skills necessary to analyze motorcycle crashes properly.

Course Objectives include:

- Gaining understanding of special operational and crash characteristics of motorcycles
- Evaluating vehicle and scene data
- Being able to interpret basic statistical information
- Understanding motorcycle braking
- Understanding vector momentum diagrams
- Being aware of various reference sources for motorcycles
- Being prepared to select friction values for various situations – braking, sliding, etc.

About the Instructor: Mr. Bartlett not only has the background of a well-qualified reconstructionist, with an advanced mechanical engineering degree and law enforcement experience, but is a race-proven motorcycle rider with years of riding experience and thousands of miles ridden. Bartlett will help each student, especially those who have never ridden a motorcycle before, to understand the complexities of collisions involving motorcycles and provide valuable insight to the reconstruction of those collisions. Each student will receive a large 3-ring binder filled with reference material they will benefit from throughout their investigator/reconstructionist career.
